Information for Applicants

General

RMEGI Scholarship Program was developed to recognize outstanding students at any accredited institute of higher learning who are planning careers in golf course management, turfgrass management, turfgrass science or other golf industry-related careers. An annual award of \$2,000 will be funded by the RMEGI and administered by the RMEGI Board of Trustees

Applications will be reviewed by the RMEGI Scholarship Committee and all decisions will be final. Applicants will be notified by mail of their status. **Application deadline will be May 1st of each year.** Applicants will be notified of their status by mail prior to June 1st of the year submitted. All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the applicant and his/her educational institution.

Eligibility

1. Eligible applicants must either be a **COLORADO RESIDENT** attending an institution either as an in-state **OR** out-of-state student as described in #4 below, **OR** a **NON-COLORADO RESIDENT** attending an institution in **COLORADO** as described in #4 below.
2. An applicant must be an undergraduate student and currently enrolled in a one or more year accredited program. (Graduating seniors are ineligible.)
3. Applicants must have completed the first year (12 credit hours or equivalent) in a program related to golf course management, turfgrass management, turfgrass science or other golf industry-related degree.
4. The student must be enrolled full-time or part-time at an accredited institution of higher learning (college or university), accredited technical college, community college 1 or 2-year program or other educational-related endeavor deemed appropriate by the Committee. Students enrolled full-time or part-time in an on-line degree program that meets the above criteria are also eligible.
5. Any number of students from the same family may apply, but only one student per family will be eligible to receive an award each year.
6. Awards may be granted to past winners in consecutive year(s).
7. Relatives or children of the RMEGI Scholarship Committee or its Board of Trustees are not eligible for this program.

Criteria for Selection

1. Applicants will be evaluated based on academic achievement, potential to become a leading professional, extracurricular activities, community involvement, and employment history.
2. The student must submit an original essay of 500 words or less. The essay must be original and not previously submitted to the RMEGI Scholarship Committee.
3. A written recommendation from a current academic advisor is required using the **Academic Advisor's Report Form**.
4. Financial need is not a determining factor in the selection.

How to Apply

Students must complete and submit the attached application form and supply the following under one cover:

1. Official transcripts from all universities and post-secondary schools attended that include grades from the last completed semester.
2. The **Academic Advisor's Report** completed by your academic advisor or the head of the department at the school that you currently attend. The form should be in an envelope sealed by the advisor and mailed with your application.
3. Typed original essay component must not exceed 500 words, and has not been previously submitted to the RMEGI Scholarship Committee.
4. **All applications must be postmarked by May 1st of the year of application.**
5. Additional application forms can be obtained from Rocky Mountain Environmental Golf Institute
6. Please follow instructions exactly.
7. Send the application packet to:

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Your scholarship application will be judged by its appearance. It is important to remember the following tips:

1. Read the instructions carefully.
2. Request information that you have to obtain from others early. In cases where your school will be sending transcripts directly to us, check back with the school about a week after making your request to ensure your transcripts have been sent.
3. If you have questions, call the number on the application.
4. Try and have your application arrive as early as possible.
5. Provide all the information required. Do not submit an incomplete application.
6. Do not include extra items.
7. Proof all materials. Have one or two other people proof your essay. Use spell check.
8. Type your application. If you do not have a computer or a typewriter, go to the computer lab at your school.
9. Be neat. If you need additional pages to answer a question, use them.
10. Use white paper. Do not use staples.
11. Make copies of your finished application for reference.

Checklist for a complete application

- Carefully complete each question in application.
- Sign where indicated.
- Attach all official transcripts from any university and post-secondary school that include grades from the last completed semester.
- Include Academic Advisor Report in sealed envelope
- Attach required essay.
